1. Will Dr. Engrave work with Windows® 95, Windows® 98, or Windows® NT 4.0?

Yes, Dr. Engrave is a 32 bit application software for Windows® 95/98/NT.

2. Can Dr. Engrave create stroke fonts to minimize engraving time?

Yes, Dr. Engrave can create stroke fonts to minimize the time for engraving. Stroke fonts created by Dr. Engrave can be modified by using the single font edit command.

3. Can Dr. Engrave import a Microsoft Excel file in CSV. format?

Yes, Dr. Engrave can import data in CSV format from other applications to produce layouts for text boxes. This allows you to engrave many different text strings (for example, many different names) with the same format (uniform text boxes) very quickly.

4. System requirement:

Windows® 95:

- Processor = I486SX is required (Pentium 100 MHz is recommended)
- System Memory = 8 MB is required (16 MB recommended)
- Hard Disk = 3.5 MB of free space

Windows® 98/NT:

- Processor = I486DX (Pentium 100 MHz recommended)
- System Memory = 16 MB is required (32 MB recommended)
- Hard Disk = 3.5 MB of free space
